

HOW TO REACH THE PAPER TRAIL

Apsley is the southern suburb of Hemel Hempstead in Hertfordshire. The Paper Trail operates two sites, just a short distance from each other along the London Road, the A4251, running from Hemel Hempstead to Kings Langley and Junction 20 on the M25. The main Paper Trail offices, Conference Centre and meeting rooms are located in Apsley Mills Cottage which together with the John Dickinson Enterprise Centre, comprise the Apsley Mills site. Our heritage Paper Mill and Paper Skills Training Centre is located at Frogmore Mill.

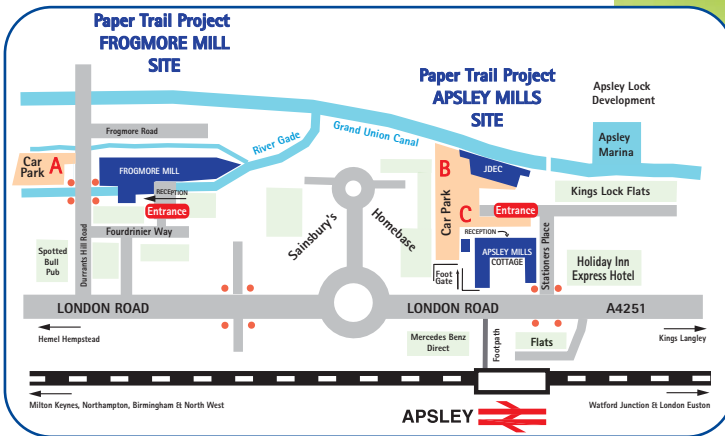
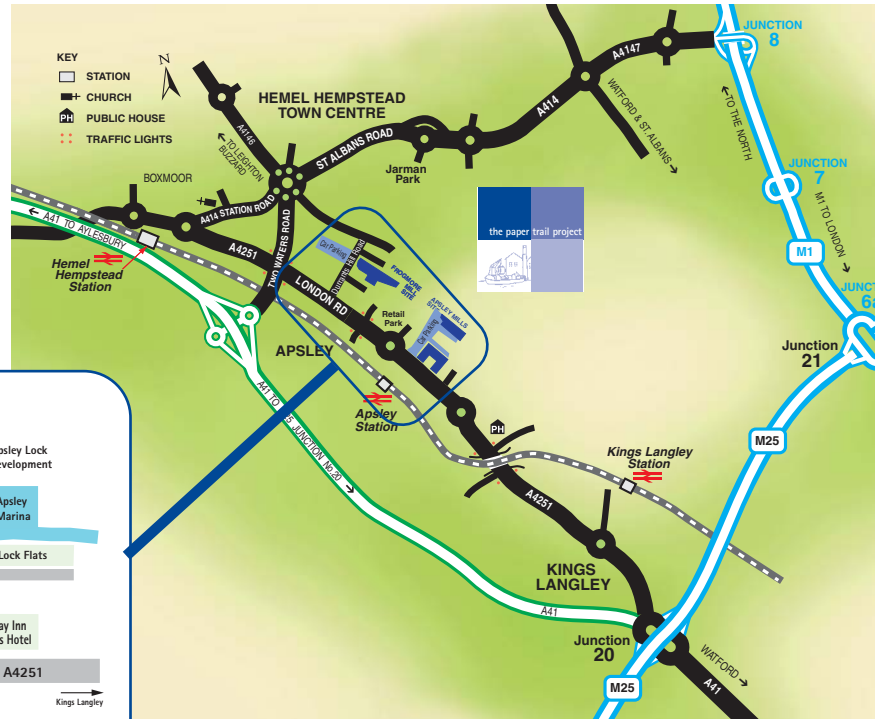

APPROACHING FROM THE SOUTH

Apsley Mills Cottage & the John Dickinson Enterprise Centre (JDEC)

From the M25 take the A4251, London Road, through Kings Langley and on past the Red Lion Pub. The entrance to the Apsley Mills site is on your right at the traffic lights immediately after the Holiday Inn Express hotel. Turn right into Stationers Place then left into the Paper Trail site. Visitors to the Cottage should use car park area C and visitors to the JDEC building should use area B. A pedestrian entrance is located on the retail park side of the cottage close beside the Basildon Bond clock. This is almost immediately opposite the footpath which gives direct access to the site from Apsley Station (a one minute walk).



Frogmore Mill

To reach Frogmore Mill, take the A4251, London Road from Kings Langley past the Apsley Mills Site, across the mini roundabout (entrance to the Retail Park - Sainsbury's & Homebase) and across the next set of traffic lights (Dunelm Mill store on right). Take the second turning right into Durrant's Hill Road (Spotted Bull pub on far corner) and then park in car park A on the left just after the traffic lights at the River Gade Bridge. Cross the road by the pedestrian crossing, turn right and take the first left, Fourdiner Way and enter the mill by the driveway on your left, just after White Lion Street (on your right).

APPROACHING FROM THE NORTH

Frogmore Mill

From the traffic lights at the junction of London Road and Two Waters Road (from A41 or the 'magic roundabout'), turn south towards Apsley along the A4251. After the pedestrian traffic lights in Apsley, take the first left into Durrant's Hill Road (Spotted Bull pub on near corner) and then park in car park A on the left just past the traffic lights at the River Gade Bridge. Cross the road by the pedestrian crossing, turn right and take the first left, Fourdiner Way and enter the mill by the driveway on your left, just after White Lion Street (on your right).

Apsley Mills Cottage & the John Dickinson Enterprise Centre (JDEC)

From the traffic lights at the junction of London Road and Two Waters Road (from A41 or the 'magic roundabout'), turn south towards Apsley along the A4251. Continue through Apsley, past the traffic lights beside the Dunelm Mill store and across the mini roundabout entrance to the Retail Park (Sainsbury's and Homebase on your left). The Apsley Mills site entrance is on your left, at the next traffic lights. Turn left into Stationers Place then left again into the Paper Trail site. Visitors to the Cottage should use car park area C and visitors to the JDEC building should use area B. A pedestrian entrance is located on the retail park side of the cottage close beside the Basildon Bond clock. This is almost immediately opposite the footpath which gives direct access to the site from Apsley Station (a one minute walk).
